










Larry says, "Not many winning hopes in this Class 5 Poly sprint over 1200m and it may be a grade dropper in **GOLDEN THUNDER** who is hardest to beat. The 6YO was never involved last start so happy to ignore that run and take on his placed effort at his start prior. Likewise, **MY FRIENDS** will appreciate the drop in Class and more importantly being back on the Poly and must be respected. The only last start winner in the race - **FYLING YELLOW** - is not only in form but has trialled well recently so picks himself, while **PERFORMANTE** is due and should figure with **WHISTLE GRAND** also in the mix. Watch the market on the likes of **TINGLE MARC**, **BLITZ POWER** and **GOLD FAITH**.

Betting Strategy - small win **GOLDEN THUNDER**."

Larry says, "Mark Walker sends out plenty of runners and the Champion Trainer looks to have the top three chances in this Restricted Maiden in **OUR SECRET WEAPON**, **TAKE A CHANCE** and **LADY ROXANNE**. Of the trio, both **OUR SECRET WEAPON** and **TAKE A CHANCE** both did it tough at their respective debuts and both did well to place on the back of good trial form. The pair have drawn better today and should figure heavily throughout with perhaps **OUR SECRET WEAPON** the pick given the support he had on debut and the 3kg claim won't hurt. The filly - **ANLADY ROXNE** - won her most recent trial in Singapore and won a trial in NZ before arrival so has to be some hope with market best guide on the Walker trio. Of the rest, **SESON** pulled up lame on debut and showed enough to follow with the tote the only guide on a plethora of newcomers who have shown glimpses at the trials.

Larry says, "Not many winning hopes on recent form in this Class 4, however, **TRADING POST** looks an exciting type and happy to keep following. Yes, he has drawn a tad sticky and steps up to 1400m, but he is undefeated at three career starts (one in Australia) and showed enough speed at his Singapore debut to think he overcomes the wide gate and can win again. There is another last start winner in the race in **AFALONHRO** and he certainly looks well-placed to give a sight with only an extra 2,5kg to carry, although **THUNDER** just got pipped in the same race and connections will be confident he can turn the tables with the weight pull. **BORN TO WIN** ran on to place last start and we can expect much the same with no weight. Numbers 3, 4, 5, 7 and 14 for the skinny end of exotics.

Betting Strategy - TRADING POST win."








Larry says, "With no real standout from the raced-brigade in this Restricted Maiden, a couple of debutantes in **MIEJ** and **TIGER LEAP** can earn an early cheque for connections. Of the two, **MIEJ** has had three good trials leading into this so 1400m on debut should not be a problem with the experienced Louis Beuzelin a factor from gate 11. **TIGER LEAP** has also drawn wide in gate 10 but like **MIEJ**, has had three good trials under his belt and no reason to think he won't run a big race on debut with Simon Kok to ride. Of the raced brigade, **HARD TO THINK** was solid without being spectacular on debut but appreciates the run and step up in trip and Vlad Duric is always a factor. **ENTERTAINER** has two third placings from two career starts to his name and while he finished a distance from the winner on both occasions, he will figure, while **SPEEDY MISSILE** ran on well to place in a spread out field at his second start and a repeat would have a say.

Larry says, "With some new balloting regulations in effect this season, there are some anomalies to keep an eye on and the two emergencies being the equal top-rated horses in this field is one such event. **EXTRA WIN** and **BARTIMAEUS** are the two emergencies and while their recent form reads badly, both should grow a leg dropping from Class 4. **EXTRA WIN** looks the pick of the two and happy to think he can go forward and run most of these off their feet and a win would not surprise. The other Class dropper is **SUPER RAY** and while he will better over longer, he is better than Class 5 and should play a significant role in this weak race. **TRIGAMY** is resuming and gets blinkers on the back of a good trial so is a contender with **WELL DESERVED** also a show but Duric will need to be very positive early after drawing the widest gate.

Betting Strategy - EXTRA WIN win if he gets a start, otherwise SUPER RAY."








Larry says, "The second division of the Restricted Maiden over 1400m and again a debutante from the Mike Clements stable may have a big say with **MARIKH**. The Australian-bred 4YO has three good trials under his belt and from gate 4, he will get every chance over 1400m with Louis Beuzelin up. But unlike division (race 4), there are a few handy types with race fitness on their side that could be hard to beat. Duric jumps on **IN ALL HIS GLORY** for Cliff Brown and the 4YO looks due with 1400m sans blinkers ideal. Of the rest that can win, two horses - **ALFARES** and **THE SHADOW** - come into this after placing at their last starts and don't have to improve much to win this, while **GNOTHI SEAUTON** had excuses last start and can win on what he showed on debut on the back of a good trial.

Larry says, "Although there is a query on the top weight after failing at his Singapore debut, **SUPER INVINCIBLE** can win if right in what looks a very good Class 4 Poly sprint. The 4YO had heart issues when missing a place as the odds-on pop on that occasion but a subsequent strong trial suggests that may have been an anomaly and he is heard to beat on his Australian form. There are two last start winners in the field - both from the Des Koh stable - and **MOONGATE STAR** will carry the same weight thanks to a Hakim 3kg claim so has to be a show, while the first emergency - **THOMAS DE LAGO** - will also have a say if he gets a start. Of the others, both **AL GREEN** and **ROYAL PAVILION** have drawn wide but both can be very strong late if the race is run to suit. **CALIFORNIA** probably the best of the rest with market best guide.


